

CROCHET STITCH: THE TWISTY STITCH



Materials needed:

- Crochet hook (I like to use a 5.5mm hook)
- Aster & Vine t-shirt yarn or 3 strand recycled cotton rope

Stitches used: knit stitch, yarn over, chain





- To set up for the twisty stitch you will first need to cast on to your wooden basket bottom and then complete one full round of knit stitches.
- Chain 1 at the end of each round.
- To start your twisty stitch, you will insert your hook into the regular place under the two loops of the stitch below
- Once your hook is through the loops, yarn over.
- Pull the loop back through the stitch.
- You will now have two loops on your hook.



- With both loops on your hook, pull your hook down and to the bottom right of the stitch below.
- Insert your hook and yarn over again.











- Pull the loop through, you will now have three loops on your hook.
- Pull your hook back to the top of your stitch.
- Yarn over again and pull through all three loops.

• You have now completed your first twisty stitch!

• For your first round you will be starting each stitch by inserting your hook through the "V" of the stitch below.

- On your second round of twisty stitches everything remains the same.
- Insert your hook to the left (under the two loops), pull that loop through and down.
- When inserting your hook to the right, it will be at the halfway point of your previous stitch.
- Continue working your twisty stitch.
