CROCHET STITCH: THE KNIT STITCH



Materials needed (if creating a basket):

- Aster & Vine wooden basket bottom (any size)
- 9mm – 11mm crochet hook
- Aster & Vine t-shirt yarn or 3 strand recycled cotton rope

Stitches used: Knit Stitch, chain 1



- The knit stitch is a variation of the single crochet stitch. However, instead of inserting your hook through the loops at the top, you insert it through the “V” of the stitch below.



- Insert your hook into the “V” of the stitch below.
- Once your hook is on the other side, yarn over



- Pull your hook back through. You will now have two loops on your hook.



- Yarn over again.



- Pull through both loops on your hook.
- You have now completed your first knit stitch!
- Continue working around your basket, at the end of each round chain 1 before beginning your next round.



- You will find once you get to your second round that the “V” becomes much easier to distinguish.
