LARGE TAPESTRY BASKET



Materials needed:

- 8" Wooden basket bottom
- Aster & Vine t-shirt yarn (1 roll colour A, 1 roll colour B)
- Size 5-6mm crochet hook
- Size 9 – 11mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

Stitches used: Single Crochet, Knit Stitch, Slip Stitch, Seamless join

Gauge: 4 stitches and 5 rows = 2"

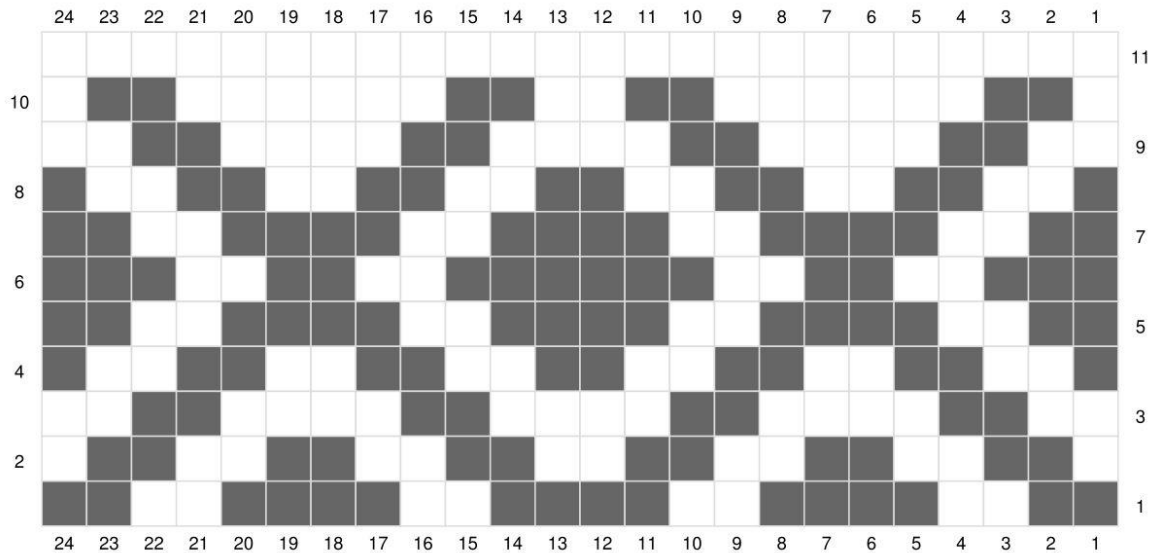
Colours used in picture are Seafoam and Light Grey

Round 1:

- Using your smaller hook and colour A, cast onto the wooden basket bottom, place a slip stitch onto your hook:
 - Insert your hook through the first hole and pull the yarn back through the wooden base.
 - Make a loose single crochet stitch, working around the wood.
 - Continue in the same manner all around the wooden basket base.

Round 2 and up:

- Switch to your larger sized hook. This is the hook you will continue using for the remainder of your basket.
- Using the **knit stitch** follow the chart below, working the chart twice for each round.
- At the end of each round join rounds using the seamless join technique (or alternatively you can ch.1 at the end of each round. This will leave a small "seam" where your rounds are joined.



Finishing Rounds:

- As per the chart, your last full round of knit stitches will be entirely in colour B.
- For the final round, use colour A and slip stitch into the back loop of the previous round.
- Cut yarn, pull through, and weave in ends with tapestry needle.
