

## THE SEAMLESS JOIN FOR CROCHET KNIT STITCH



This tutorial will show you how to create a seamless join when crocheting using the Knit Stitch and working in the round.



• Work your first round, when you complete your last stitch remove your crochet hook.




 Insert your hook from back to front under the two loops of your first stitch from Round 1



 Hook your loop from the last stitch of Round 1 and pull it through to the back of your work and remove your hook



This picture shows the loop which is now on the back side of your work.



 Insert your hook through the "V" of the first stitch of Round 1, yarn over and pull through



With the loop you pulled through held off to the side so that it stays on the back of your work, yarn over and pull through.



- Place the loop that you pulled to the back of your work back on your hook.
- Yarn over and pull through.
- Continue working your next round. Complete these steps at the end of each round and you will have a seamless join!
