

## HOW TO MAKE A SMALL MACRAME WALL HANGING



## Materials needed:

- 75 feet of 5mm Aster & Vine Recycled Cotton Rope
- 1 piece of dowel (or branch) approximately 11" long
- Scissors & tape (optional)

Knots used: Lark's Head knot, Spiral Knot, Square knot

## Step 1:

- Cut 10 pieces of rope, 7.5 feet each
- Optional: Secure the ends of your rope with tape to prevent fraying. Once you are finished the wall hanging you
  can cut the tape off.



**Step 2:** Fold each piece of rope in half and attached to your dowel using a Lark's Head knot

**Step 3:** Working left to right, tie a column of 6 spiral knots using the first 4 cords. When complete move to the next 4 cords and tie another column of 6 spiral knots. Continue working your way across until you have 5 columns of spiral knots.

**Step 4:** Tie 3 rows of square knots. For the first row leave the outer two cords aside. For the middle row use all of the cords. For the final row leave the outer two cords aside.

**Step 5:** This is the same as *Step 3*. Working left to right, tie 5 columns of 6 spiral knots each.

Step 6: Tie 6 increasingly smaller rows of square knots. For the first row, leave the outer 2 cords. For the second row, use all of the cords. For the third row, leave the outer 2 cords. For the fourth row you will leave the outer 4 cords, you will have 3 square knots in this row. For the fifth row leave the outer 6 cords for a total of 2 knots. And for the final row, leave the outer 8 cords, this row will only have 1 knot in the middle.

## Finishing:

• Trim the ends of the rope to your desired length.
